

Rate Recommendation:

Based on the preliminary financial sufficiency models developed by RevPlan, the annual asset investment requirement, the need to build cash reserves, and the water production reports and billing information, FRWA recommends that the System pursue the proposed "Best Case Scenario" presented. In addition, FRWA strongly encourages the System to review RevPlan, growth projections and Consumer Price Index (CPI) changes at least annually to determine if additional rate increases are needed as well as to pursue aggressively alternative revenue funding sources for the future capital projects identified in the Capital Improvements Plan.
